ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Assigns, reviews and analyzes the clinical work of assigned staff relating to therapy, testing and evaluation, reports of treatment, behavior and progress of client.
- Provides in-service training for staff through individual conferences or staff meetings to develop therapeutic techniques and ensure compliance to all treatment regulations, and delivery of quality treatment.
- Responsible for the appropriate release of treatment-related correspondence, and the timely preparation and submission of all required program reports, records and documentation in accordance with regulatory standards and program policy.
- Coordinates program outreach and public relations activities, provides community education and technical assistance to other social service providers, as well as client family members.
- Provides clinical back-up for treatment staff, as needed, to ensure program continuity.
- Adheres to all policies, laws, regulations and codes of ethics and confidentiality as outlined by federal and state laws, and agency policies and procedures.

- Master's Degree in Social Work, Psychology or related social services field, with a minimum of three years' progressive experience in human services.
