- Assists the Project Director with recruitment/enrollment and screening of students for the Program.
- Daily oversight of mentors, student participants and activities.
- Implements evaluation tools, i.e. pre/post testing, surveys, etc. and serves on the LEARN Evaluation Team
- Assists Program Director with mentor application process, screenings, orientation and on-going training sessions.
