ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Responsible for completing all activities and assignments necessary to maintain the general repair and safety of buildings, equipment and grounds.
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- Minor drywall repairs
- Makes plumbing, electrical and mechanical repairs.
- Repairs equipment as needed.
- Paints room, hallways, and other areas as needed.
- Assist Maintenance Team with projects as needed.
- Maintains inventory of supplies including receipt.
- Transport and supervise residents to various appointments and community activities.
- Adheres to all policies, laws, regulations and codes of ethics and confidentiality as outlined by federal and state laws, and agency policies and procedures.

- Ability to observe and identify potential problems and notify supervisor.
